

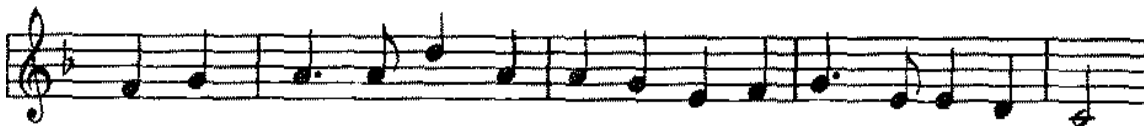

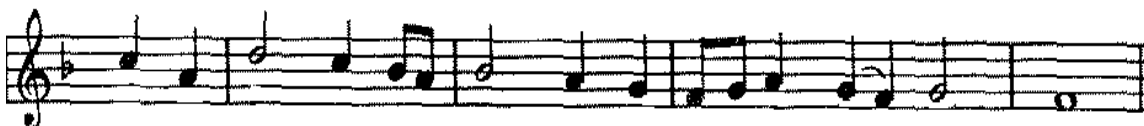

What with care and toil we build-eth, tow'r and tem-ple, fall to dust.



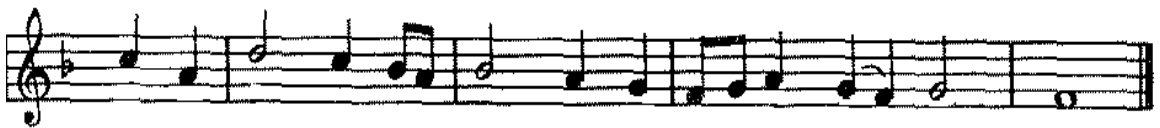
God un - known, He a__ - lone calls our hearts_ to be__ His own.
