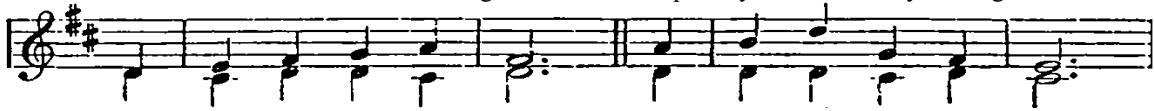


## #93 *You Servants of The Lord*
